

Springport Planning Board Minutes October 15, 2025

Meeting was called to order by Chair Mike Sacco at 7:00PM.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited

Members present: Mike Sacco, Karen Luziani, Amy Rindfleisch-Alcock, Cathy Dreverman, Donna O'Hara, Jon Patterson and Lance Winter

Minutes from the September 17, 2025 meeting were read. Karen will update the minutes to state that if the zoning change from Agricultural to Industrial goes through and no action has been taken on that property within five (5) years, that zoning will revert back to Agricultural. The Town of Springport Comprehensive Plan needs to be updated and state that we will use the NYS "Sunset Clause" in this particular case. A motion was made by Jon Patterson and seconded by Lance Winter to approve the September 17, 2025 minutes after appropriate changes have been made. Motion carried.

The board discussed the cost of mailers including who pays if they are sent out – the Planning Board or the Town Board. Does the Planning Board have a budget?

Jon Patterson shared with the board that Wilson Press in Seneca Falls handles any printing needs that Patterson Farms has and finds their prices to be fair and are less than prices from Jacobs Press. Karen will call Wilson Press and obtain information should we need to send a mailer to Town of Springport residents in the future.

Mike will call Evan Tuthill, Senior Planner, Cayuga County Dept. of Planning and Economic Development, regarding any further steps the NYS DEC may be taking.

Motion made by Donna O'Hara to adjourn and seconded by Cathy Dreverman. Motion carried, meeting adjourned at 8:00PM.
